RULES

Purchase hand entry form in advance from any Ninety-Nine or at any airport on route. One entry form is issued with each hand purchased. Start at any designated airport after 9:30 AM. At each airport receive a card which is stapled to the entry form and the value is marked on the form by the official before another card is drawn. If you do not fly to all the airports listed above, your hand(s) will be completed at the Terminus. All stops will close at 1:00 PM. Hand(s) must be submitted by 1:30 PM at the Airport Grille at New Bedford Airport.

ABSOLUTE DEADLINE AT THE TERMINUS (AIRPORT GRILLE) IS 1:30 PM.

Entry fee is \$10 per hand or 3 hands for \$25. You may purchase as many hands as desired. There is no limit to the number of hands that can be carried aboard an aircraft.

Anyone may purchase hands. Purchasers of hands do not need to be pilots, fly to any of the airports, or be present for awarding prizes. (You may designate someone to select your prize if you will be unable to be present at the Terminus); you may drive or fly to the Terminus by the 1:30 PM deadline for prize selection, or designate someone to submit your entries and select your prize. Winning hands are based on traditional poker hand ranking. First place hand has the first pick of prizes. The next highest hand is the next to choose. This process will continue until all prizes have been distributed. In the case of a tie, an additional card will be drawn by the tied entrants. High card wins.

All flights must remain in VFR conditions. Weather below VFR minimums or wind in excess of 15 knots will postpone the event. A GO/NO GO decision will be made no later than 7:30 AM on Saturday, September 22 or Sunday if needed. Call (508) 495-1021 for recorded message.
