A couple of weeks ago, Jessie Zuberek, Chair of the Eastern New England Chapter, passed on an idea from the Treasure Island Chapter to reward our Air Traffic Controllers with Christmas cookies.

- 1. Identify towers, flight schools, FBOs, etc. that you will visit. If there are possible overlaps with other members, reach out and coordinate the deliveries.
- 2. VERY IMPORTANT! Contact local towers for authorization and coordination (you can't just show up at the Tower!)
- 3. Bake or buy your favorite cookies/sweets.
- 4. Pack up your package
 - a. Shirt boxes/gift boxes from the dollar stores work great as cookie boxes. They are affordable and you can often find holiday motifs in the stores this time of year.
 - b. Festive outfits/costumes are encouraged at the cookie deliveries make for great pictures and everyone loves it!
 - c. Sign a *Certificate of Appreciation* for each delivery. Maybe have a couple of extra's just in case. Add your tail #, if applicable, so they'll "recognize" you.
- 5. Deliver cookies. Dress in your most colorful and fun holiday outfits!
- 6. Please take pictures, if allowed, and share! Some Tower staff/management allow pictures, some don't.
