Evelyn Kropp (92) of Norwich, Connecticut was a CT Chapter and Life Member of the 99s.

She learned to fly in 1967, IFR in 1968, commercial and multi in 1969, then CFI and CFII. Evelyn owned a Piper Arrow for 54 years (nicknamed "Romeo"). She was very active in the New England Section 99s as well as her Chapter. She served as governor, and many Chapter officer positions. Her experience was a wealth of information, and she enjoyed encouraging and mentoring all of us who knew her. She participated in the annual International 99s Conferences and never missed a Section meeting. Her commitment and dedication to the 99s family was inspirational.

Evelyn was an avid air racer. She started racing in the Powder Puff Derby races and continued when the name changed to Air Race Classic. In 1976, she flew two races. In the first race, the Angel Derby, she flew solo from Quebec, Canada to Fort Lauderdale, FL and then she flew the Powder Puff Derby from Sacramento, CA to Wilmington, Delaware with a copilot.

Evelyn served as an FAA Accident Prevention Counselor for over 30 years, and the Wright Brothers Master Pilots Award was presented to Evelyn for 50 years of safe flying in 2017.

We will all miss her kind and gentle manner and her adventurous spirit.

Evelyn's service will be next Wednesday. Her two sons have invited us all to gather at her house following the church service – they know how important her 99s family was to Evelyn.
