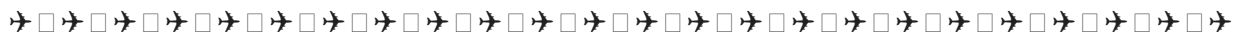

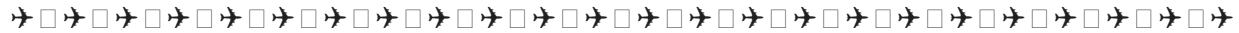

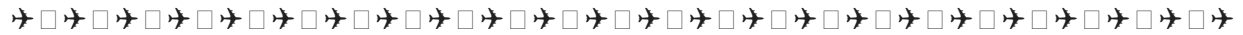

Amelia Earhart Memorial Scholarship

The scholarship is for licensed pilot section members to advance in training and education in aviation and aerospace, including scholarships to complete additional pilot certificates and ratings, jet type ratings, college degrees, technical training and an Emergency Maneuver Training Scholarship established in memory of 99 member Vicki Cruse.

- Research Scholar Grant to add to the world's knowledge of women in aviation and aerospace
- Flight training up to \$20,000 for additional pilot certificate or rating
- Technical training for aerospace technical training or certification course up to \$20,000
- Academic training is awarded up to \$10,000
- Vicki Cruse Emergency Maneuver Training covers the entire cost of the training.

Application deadline is January 1, 2025. Send application to your Chapter Chair. She must submit it by January 1
